

A-levels: how your school fared

A-LEVEL pass rates rose to a record 97.2 per cent this year, with state school pupils in London and the South-East sharing in the success. The Evening Standard's survey of exam performance in the region, based on information supplied by more than 200 schools, details their achievement. Our table breaks down into five columns of information. The first shows whether the school is single-sex or

The Evening Standard's results league for state schools in London and the South-East

mixed, and the second whether it selects pupils by academic ability. The third shows the number of exam candidates in the final year of the sixth form. The fourth column, on which the schools are ranked,

shows the percentage of A-level passes at grades A and B. The fifth column shows the average points scored by each pupil in A-level and AS-level combined, on the Universities and Colleges

Admissions Service scale. UCAS gives 120 points for an A grade at A-level and 60 points for the same grade at AS. Where schools are tied, the first ranking goes to the school with the largest number of pupils,

as it is more difficult to maintain peak performance the bigger the group of students. Locations are shown in bold. The top school in our survey, with 96 per cent As and Bs, was Queen Elizabeth's Boys School in Barnet. This table is not comprehensive as some schools did not supply their results. The definitive ranking will be provided when the Government publishes official tables early next year.
